Behavioural Guidelines and Expectations – For Adults

At events, all members have the right to:

Feel Safe

Be respected

For this to happen members are expected to behave politely and respectfully towards other members.

Behaviours that do NOT allow other members to enjoy these rights are not acceptable and a series of warnings will be issued to any members that do not follow the behavioural guidelines.

Warnings:

Our Duty of Care begins from the moment you become a member.

The Murray Bridge Players & Singers committee authorize that warnings can be given by the Director of the production or a member of the committee.

First warning - The member will be reminded about their behavior and the expectations

Second warning – The member will be asked to leave the event and consider their options and the Committee will discuss further actions if necessary

Third warning—The members fees will be forfeited, and they will not continue in that event

In the circumstance of a serious transgression, a member may go straight to a third warning. These warnings will be documented.

Rehearsal and Performance Expectations

RESPECT – Yourself, all members and other persons involved in the event and the property

LISTEN & FOCUS – stop talking immediately when asked to and follow directions

BE SAFE AND HAPPY - We should all feel safe and respected by all at any event

Violence, offensive language & actions, harassment, put downs or excluding members is NOT acceptable.

MOBILE PHONES – I PADS ~ I PODS ETC & PRIVACY We ask members to be respectful using electronic devices and social media

We encourage members NOT to take photos with their electronic devices without consent and to be sensitive of others around them. This is outlined in the Image Consent form.

Behavioural Guidelines and Expectations – For Students

At FOUNDATION and YOUTH THEATRE all students have the right to:

Feel Safe

Be respected

Have the opportunity to learn

In order for this to happen students are expected to behave politely and respectfully towards other students, Youth Theatre Coordinator and any other adults who are in the company. This includes class time, rehearsal time and at performances.

Behaviour that does NOT allow other students to enjoy these rights is not acceptable and a series of warnings will be issued to any student who does not follow the behavioural guidelines.

Warnings:

First warning - The student will be reminded about their behavior and the expectations

Second warning - Parents will be contacted and students will be unable to attend the next session

Third warning – Parents will be contacted, and the students will be asked to leave the Foundation or Youth Theatre and their fees will be forfeit.

These warnings will be documented.

The Murray Bridge Players & Singers committee authorize that warnings can be given by the Youth Theatre Coordinator or by a member of the committee.

Our Duty of care begins from the moment the student enters the theatre until they leave. For this reason, if a student needs to leave class early for any reason, we would ask that they be collected by a designated adult, or in the case of an older student, we request parents provide a written note or phone call. The roll book that is marked each week will reflect early departures.

Rehearsal and Performance Expectations

RESPECT — Yourself, each other, Youth Theatre Coordinator, adults, volunteers, the theatre, NO climbing over furniture, leaving rubbish, touching other's property, including costumes & props, & NO running in the theatre

LISTEN & FOCUS — stop talking immediately when asked to and follow directions

BE SAFE AND HAPPY — We should all feel safe and respected by all at the theatre. Violence, offensive language or actions, harassment, put downs or excluding class members is NOT acceptable.

MOBILE PHONES – I PADS ~ I PODS ETC AND PRIVACY We ask students NOT to bring their phones to rehearsals and performances at all. If however, they need to bring their phone with them, they will be placed in a communal Phone Box.

The Youth Theatre Coordinator will carry their phone if parents need to make contact should the need arise.

We encourage students NOT to take photos with their electronic devices and to be sensitive of others around them. This is outlined in the Image Consent form.
